

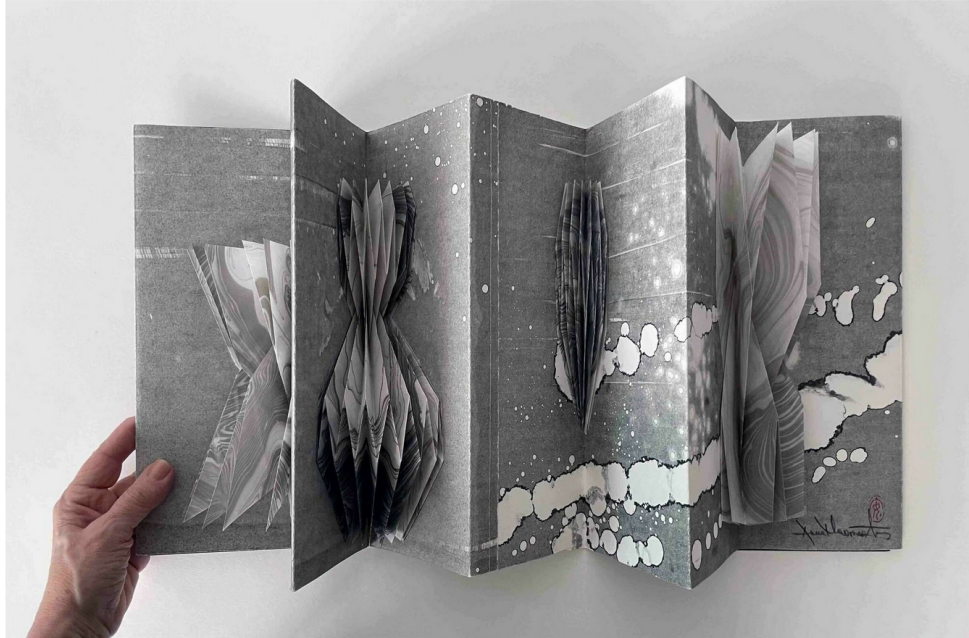

Book Arts of Houston

Curator Erica Reed Lee pulled together works by 30 artists with Houston connections – Trenton Doyle Hancock, Anna Mavromatis, Charis Ammon, Keliy Anderson-Staley among them – for "Book Arts of Houston." True to its name, the exhibition presents works by locals that have found their way into the book publishing medium. Reed's show captures the breadth of art and design used to bring a book to life, including artist books and bookbinding. The show opened in April and closes at the end of Saturday.
